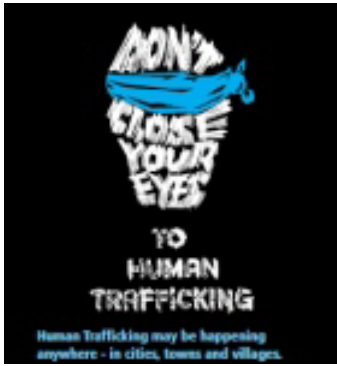


Red Card for Forced Prostitution against Trafficking in Women

Amnesty International, the Coalition Against Trafficking in Women (CATW), and various church-based organizations worked to highlight concerns about forced prostitution and sex trafficking around the 2006 World Cup – where it was anticipated that between 30,000 and 60,000 women and girls may have been dragooned into the 'sex huts' being established in many of the 12 venues for the tournament in Germany. Anti-trafficking groups point out that vulnerable women have been trafficked into Germany to meet the extra 'demand' created by advertising for sex services.

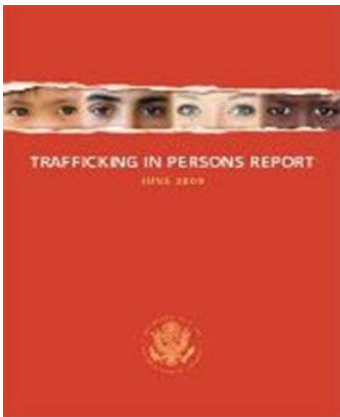


Not For Sale

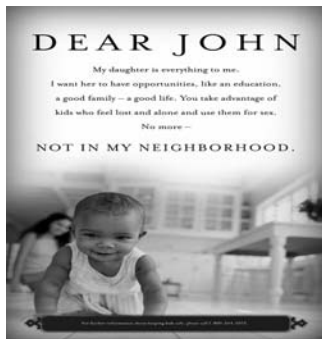


National runaway switchboard

GEMS was founded in 1999 by Rachel Lloyd, a young woman who had been sexually exploited as a teenager. GEMS has helped hundreds of young women and girls, ages 12-21, who have experienced commercial sexual exploitation and domestic trafficking to exit the commercial sex industry and to develop to their full potential. GEMS provides young women with empathetic, consistent support and viable opportunities for positive change.

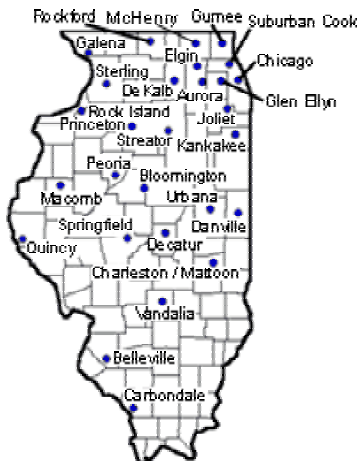


Promoting awareness victim empowerment
